What is the United Way of Washington County?

- Our mission is to unite people, resources, and organizations to improve lives in Washington County.
- We are a separate, independent 501(c)(3) nonprofit, a member of United Way Worldwide, led by a local volunteer board of directors comprised of 19 local community members.
- We are one of 1,100 United Ways in the network of United Way Worldwide, 800 of them in the U.S.
- For almost 100 years, since 1925, our United Way has focused on the needs of our community members right here in Washington County.
- Today, dollars that are raised are then redistributed to local nonprofits who align with our vision of a community where everyone achieves their human potential through education, financial stability, and healthy lives.

How does the United Way of Washington County have a presence in the community?

- Our presence is demonstrated by the continuous annual funding of local nonprofit programs that results from generous donors including those from Workplace Giving Campaigns, our Impact Circle membership and through various fundraisers.
- In FY2022-23, \$252,505 of Community Impact Fund grants was used to fund 39 programs of 20 nonprofit community partners that benefit 40,359 community members.
- In FY2022-23, the Veterans United Fund was established. In its first year, \$42,341 was granted to four local programs that benefited local veterans.
- A newly created website at www.volunteerwashco.org allows organizations and individuals to seek volunteer opportunities in Washington County with local nonprofits.
- Community members who are in need call 2-1-1, the United Way's PA 2-1-1 Southwest help resource line, that recommends available resources in Washington County.
